- **HB 246 is NOT temporary.** There is nothing more permanent than a “temporary” program. (SEE TABLE)
- **HB 246 will likely lead to tax increases.** If school districts reduce their capital budgets, they almost certainly have to raise taxes to replace the capital they should have been caring for in the first place.
